This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner herein, in case FIR No. 77 dated 19.09.2016, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act 1959 at Police Station S.G.N. Dev Thermal Plant Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 15.01.2018 passed in CRM-M-21252-2017. It is the submission that there is no substantial difference between the allegations against the co-accused having concession of bail and the petitioner herein. This assertion is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondent-State who is being instructed by ASI Surinder Pal.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case,

the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/learned trial Court concerned subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437 (3)Cr.PC.
- 2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his presence in accordance with law. In that eventually, the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- 3. He shall not leave the country without previous permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
