On the asking of the Court, the petitioners have stated that they are temporarily staying in Village Kishangarh, UT, Chandigarh and they are apprehending threats from the hands of private respondents who are residing in West Bengal.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition. However, he states that the petitioners will file the petition for protection before the Calcutta High Court and prays that the petitioners be given interim protection for a period of one month

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, respondent Nos.1 to 3 are directed to protect the life, limb and liberty of the petitioners for a period of one month which will commence from today.
