The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017, registered under Sections 307, 326, 325, 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that only simple injury has been attributed to the petitioner and main injury has been attributed to Balwinder Singh @ Latti. Petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Rashpal Singh, learned State counsel submitted that weapons of offence have been recovered and the petitioner is no more required for custodial interrogation since the main injury has not been attributed to the petitioner.

Considering the facts of the case, the coordinate bench of this court has already granted anticipatory bail to Ajmer Singh vide order dated 15.12.2017 passed in *CRM-M-39102-2017*.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 11.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
