It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is being unnecessarily harassed despite she having submitted a complaint to the S.H.O. against M/s Sekhon Automobiles, G.T. Road, Rayya, District Amritsar, from where the petitioner purchased a new motorcycle Bajaj Pulsar bearing registration No.PB-02 PU 6313 on 24.04.2014 on instalment basis, which instalments have been paid off but another complaint on a subsequent date has been submitted by the said automobile agency against the petitioner and in pursuance thereto, ASI Subhash Kumar, Incharge of Police Post Butala, Tehsil Baba Bakala, District Amritsar, has been harassing the petitioner. He has been calling her at odd hours directing her to come to Police Post and meet him. Even her old father has been made to sit for the night at the Police Post. Threats are also being given to her that in case she refused to meet him, false case would be registered against her. Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural). She further states that she is not against joining any inquiry, provided a proper notice

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, in the light of the fact that a representation dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted by the petitioner highlighting her grievance, the same be looked into by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), and if some substance is found therein, proceed in the matter.

It is further clarified that in case the petitioner is required for inquiry purposes on a complaint which has been filed by her or is pending against her, she be given proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
