LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner seeks modification of order dated 06.12.2016/31.01.2017 and setting aside order dated 27.03.2018. Anticipatory bail was afforded to the petitioner, inter alia, with a condition that he would not leave India without permission of the Court.

An application for modification of the order was filed before the learned Sessions Judge, Chandigarh to the extent that the petitioner be permitted to leave India at will without seeking permission of the Court as required. It was submitted that due to nature of his work, it is difficult for the petitioner to seek permission to go abroad each and every time. The said application was dismissed vide order dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-6). Hence, aggrieved present petition has been filed.

Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is specifically observed by the learned Sessions Judge that when the petitioner earlier sought permission to go abroad, he was duly afforded the said concession. There is nothing on record to show that as and

when the petitioner requested for going abroad, it was not granted. I do not find any ground to permit the petitioner to leave India as per his desire. There is no ground whatsoever for modifying order dated 06.12.2016/31.01.2017 and permit the petitioner to go abroad without seeking permission from the learned trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to point out any infirmity or illegality in impugned order dated 27.03.2018.

Present petition is, accordingly, dismissed. Needless to say this Court is sanguine that as and when an application for going abroad is moved by the petitioner, learned trial Court shall dispose of the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
