SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the impugned order dated 19th July, 2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar whereby the petitioner has been declared a Proclaimed Offender in case F.I.R No.30, dated 12th February, 2016, under Sections 406/420 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 24 of Emigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise.

2. Now the complainant/respondent No.2 has arrived at a settlement with the accused persons vide Compromise Deed (Annexure P-4), which is duly signed by him.

3. Since, the aforementioned FIR has already been quashed by this Court vide separate order passed in CRM-M No.43628 of 2017 today, the present petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 19th July, 2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar whereby the present petitioner has been declared a Proclaimed Offender in case F.I.R No.30, dated 12th February, 2016, under Sections 406/420 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 24 of Emigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar District Jalandhar has been rendered infructuous.

The present petition, therefore, stands disposed off as infructuous.
