Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise.

Vide order dated 03.06.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording their statements. The trial Court submitted a report on 16.09.2016 that neither the complainant nor the accused have appeared for recording their statements.

Thereafter, vide order dated 14.07.2017, one more opportunity was granted to the parties to appear before the trial Court and again a report dated 29.07.2017 has been received that none of the parties have appeared before the trial Court.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed as infructuous, at this stage. However, it will be open for the parties to file a fresh petition, in case, the parties still acknowledge the compromise.
