GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 85 dated 20.10.2016 under Sections 324, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 11.5.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of Resham Singh-complainant had

been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that Resham Singh has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been reported by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar that in his opinion the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition stands allowed and FIR No. 85 dated 20.10.2016 under Sections 324, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
