AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court with a grievance that because of the conduct of son of petitioners 1 and 2 namely Komalpreet Singh, who has eloped with daughter of respondent No.4, they are being unnecessarily harassed and humiliated as well as threatened merely because they are relatives of Komalpreet Singh.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners 1 and 2 have disowned their son and have no connection whatsoever with him. The whereabouts of Komalpreet Singh and the girl are not known to the petitioners but they apprehend that they would be falsely implicated in the case.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners be granted liberty to move a detailed representation to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Amritsar (Rural), highlighting their grievance therein, which may be considered and decided and action taken thereon.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Amritsar (Rural) that in case the petitioners submit a representation to the said authority,

the same shall be looked into and appropriate steps in accordance with law
be taken, if required.
