1. Petitioner has preferred this petition for amendment of order dated 26.10.2017 vide which regular bail was granted to the petitioner on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.1 lac with one surety in the like amount.

2. Petitioner filed an application on the ground that he being a Nigerian National is not in a position to furnish surety as ordered by the Court. He showed his willingness to deposit cash amount in place of surety. The said application was rejected by the Additional Sessions Judge, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) vide order dated 15.12.2017.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the order dated 26.10.2017, petitioner could not come

out of jail because of aforesaid technical reason.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a Nigerian National and he does not know any local surety. He is ready to furnish personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount. Petitioner is also ready to surrender his passport to ensure that he will not run away from justice.

5. Heard.

6. Petitioner is accused in FIR No.269 dated 22.07.2017 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Zirakpur, S.A.S. Nagar.

7. 50 grams of heroin was allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

8. Considering the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to modify the rider clause in order dated 26.10.2017 and to direct the petitioner to furnish personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one cash surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court. Petitioner is also directed to surrender his passport in the trial Court.
