Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of bail granted to respondent no.2 in FIR No. 290 dated 11.12.2016, vide order dated 08.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari.

The matter was adjourned on request of learned counsel for the petitioner on various occasions. On the last date of hearing, it was informed that the prosecutrix in this case has since been examined. However, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought one last opportunity to address arguments.

Today, despite the matter having been called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

It is mentioned in the petition that bail has been afforded to respondent no.2 in contravention of the provisions of law. Grave and serious allegations were raised against respondent no.2, but still bail has been afforded to respondent no.2. There is no mention of any misuse of the concession of bail pending trial by respondent no.2 after passing of order

dated 08.03.2017. Moreover, it is duly recorded on 27.11.2017 that the prosecutrix in this case has since been examined and today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, no ground is made out for cancellation of bail afforded to respondent no.2 vide order dated 08.03.2017 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
