The petitioner is seeking direction to respondent No.1 to constitute a Medical Board to examine Shamsheer Singh, who is the husband of the petitioner and has been taken in custody in FIR No.132 dated 05.04.2018 under Section 22/27-A read with Section 29/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Jodhewal Basti, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the husband of the petitioner - Shamsheer Singh, who has been detained by the police in connection with the aforementioned FIR, is mentally ill and does not understand the implication of his actions. An application in this regard has been filed before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana on 27.04.2018, but the same has not been decided as yet.

Heard.

The application preferred by the petitioner on 27.04.2018 before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana for medical examination of her

husband is stated to be under consideration of the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana. Therefore, this petition at this stage appears to be premature and no directions are called for.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of as premature at this stage. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court again in case of any undue delay in the disposal of the application preferred by her.
