Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from Dalip Kumar son of Sh. Mansa Ram, Vijay Kumar son of Sh. Dalip Kumar, Main Pal son of Sh. Jhisak Ram and Ramesh Kumar son of Sh. Main Pal, all residents of village Jhumianwali, Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka-respondent No.3, respectively.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to look into the representation dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka-respondent No.2 and Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 07.05.2018

(Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law,
if required.
