AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

On 29.08.2018 the following order was passed :-

“Service upon respondents No.1 and 4 has not been effected and application for impleading LR's of respondent No.3, who is stated to have died, has also not been filed. Respondent No.2 was served but none has entered appearance on behalf of it.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vinod Chaudhri, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2. Counsel undertakes to supply a copy of the paper book to the opposite counsel during the course of the day.

Last opportunity of three weeks has been granted to the counsel for the appellants to move an application for impleading the LR's of respondent No.3 and to furnish correct address of respondents No.1 and 4. In that event, let them be

served for 04.12.2018. However, in the failure to do so, the matter be listed on 26.09.2018 with the clearing understanding that in the event of default the appeal will be dismissed in default for non-prosecution.”

Matter was called yesterday also but none has appeared. Even today none has entered appearance on behalf of the appellants, even on second call.

Appeal stands dismissed in default.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
