In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.43 dated 14.07.2017 registered at Police Station Qadian Batala Police Distt Batala, District Gurdarapur under Section 326 IPC

2. This Court vide order dated 14.5.2018 directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to release on furnishing bond to the satisfaction of Arresting/investigating Officer.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paras Ram submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. Observation made to the order dated 14.5.2018 is remain un rebutted.

4. In view of these factual aspect, order dated 14.05.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
