In the instant petition, petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.65 dated 03.03.2016 under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

3. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 11.05.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute. Trial Court is also given liberty to initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the accused as well as surety in view of the violation of bond on 5.12.2017.
