Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) vide which, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender during the pendency of the criminal complaint filed by the respondent under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Vide order dated 08.08.2016, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court and the trial Court was directed to release the petitioner on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record certified copy of the order dated 18.08.2016 passed by the trial Court, vide which, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail. He further submits that thereafter, the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court and facing the trial.

In view of the same, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and on his furnishing bail/surety bonds, he has been released on interim bail and subsequently, he is regularly facing the trial, the impugned order dated 02.05.2016, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender is set aside, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the

District Legal Services Authority, SAS Nagar, Mohali and the order dated
08.08.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute.
