Through this application, applicants-petitioners sought to withdraw the main petition.

On 7.9.2018, following order was passed:

“Order dated 14.05.2018 has not been complied. Therefore, concerned police official is hereby directed to appear in person and apprise this Court as to why reply statement has not been filed so also non-compliance of the order dated 14.05.2018 having regard to the age of the petitioners as 70 and 57 respectively.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners was very much present in Court. Whereas petitioners and contesting respondents have entered into a compromise on 13.7.2018. Thus, petitioners should have apprised their counsel for the purpose of withdrawal or fact of compromise dated 13.7.2018 on 7.9.2018. There is a lapse on the part of the petitioners in continuing the present petition. Further due to non compliance of the order dated 14.05.2018, Senior Superintendent of Police was compelled to present in Court who is present in Court.

Accordingly, main petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- as costs by the petitioners. Cost shall be remitted to the Home Department, State of Punjab within a period of one month from today.

Application stands allowed accordingly.

Main case

In view of the order passed in CRM-35166-2018, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, disposal of this petition would not come in the way of explanation from the Senior Superintendent of Police Mr. Satinder Singh who is stated to have reported in the present post on 13.7.2018. Due to non compliance of the order dated 14.05.2018, it is stated that necessary action has been taken against ASI Lakhwinder Singh. At the same time, Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala who has reported on 13.7.2018 is hereby directed to produce necessary document to show that as and when he has reported has he made any review of the status of the various litigation which comes under the jurisdiction of Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala so as to apprise this Court that there are serious lapses on the part of ASI Lakhwinder Singh. If such review has been undertaken by the Senior Superintendent of Police, the same be made available within a period of four weeks from today.

List this matter on 12.11.2018.
