GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered vide FIR No.420 dated 23.12.2017 under Sections 307, 452, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram.

The allegations in nut-shell are that the complainant was having some dispute with the accused-party and that on the day of occurrence, the petitioner along with co-accused Om Pal came near the house of the complainant and the petitioner raised '*Lalkara*' exhorting his co-accused Om Pal to hit his car into the complainant and pursuant to the said '*Lalkara*' the co-accused Om Pal accelerated the speed of his car and

rammed his car into the main door of his house. While the complainant in order save himself went into the house, but Om Pal continued to chase him in his car and rammed his car into his house again causing grievous injuries to the wife of the complainant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and that in any case, even as per FIR, he was not driving car in question which is stated to have rammed into the injured.

On the other hand the learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the injuries were intentionally caused to Seema, wife of the complainant resulting in fracture in Pelvic region and that in these circumstances, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered rival submissions addressed before this Court and bearing in mind that car in question was not driven by the petitioner and that the petitioner has already been behind bars since last 8 ½ months, in my opinion, no fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. Accordingly, petitioner-Sohan Pal is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

This petition stands accepted accordingly.
