Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation in FIR No.90 dated 16.06.2015 under Sections 307, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh has drawn the attention of this Court to paragraphs 5 and 6 of the status report submitted by way of affidavit of Sh. Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Ferozepur, which read as under:-

“That later on moving of application by mother of Navjot Singh, enquiry of this case was conducted by SP(H), Ferozepur, who after conducting detailed enquiry has declared Jagjit Singh s/o Hardial Singh, Partap Singh s/o Bakshish Singh, Satpal Singh, Hardial Singh, Rachhpal Singh, Jasvir Singh, Darbara Singh sons of Bakshish

Singh, Rajbir Singh s/o Darbara Singh, Lovepreet Singh s/o Rachhpal Singh, Amar Singh s/o Pritam Singh, Balwinder Singh s/o Pritam Singh, Darbara Singh Namberdar, Harpreet Singh @ Happy r/o Sherpur Takhtuwala, Baltej Singh @ Sonu, Gurpreet Singh @ Preeta as real culprits of cross version, and Amrit Singh, Maninder Singh and Jasbir Singh have been declared as real culprits of main case.

That lateron on moving the application by petitioner party before Crime Branch, the enquiry of present case is pending with A.I.G. (Crime), after completion of enquiry the Assistant Inspector General of Police (Crime), Bathinda, he has sent his report to Director Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh and same report has not been received in the office of answering respondents till today.”

On the strength of the aforesaid status report, learned State Counsel submits that it is because of the application moved by the petitioner, enquiry of the present case is pending with A.I.G. (Crime) and the same is in process.

In view of the status report so submitted by Sh. Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Ferozepur, and noticing the fact that FIR in the case was registered on 16.06.2015, respondent Nos. 2 and 3 are directed to expedite the investigation and complete the same preferably within a period of six months from today.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
