AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Pursuant to the order dated 18.05.2018, learned State counsel has produced in Court today an MLR pertaining to the injuries stated to have been received by the complainant, showing that there was one incised wound 3 cm x 1 cm, bone deep below the elbow, with an X-ray advised and with the X-ray thereafter also showing a fracture due to the injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however points out that admittedly the FIR was got registered on 15.07.2017, with the case of the complainant being that the occurrence took place on 08.07.2017, i.e. one week earlier, with there being talks on effecting a compromise between them, as also recorded in the itself.

That being so, though counsel for the State & complainant have opposed the petition, without making any comment on the actual culpability of the petitioner or otherwise, the petitioner upon joining investigation, if he

is sought to be arrested, shall be admitted to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Illaqa Magistrate.
