Present petition has been filed for seeking regular bail in FIR No. 212 dated 02.12.2017 for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 186, 332, 353, 307, 427 IPC; Section 3 of the Prevention Damage to Public Property Act, 1974 and Section 8-B of the National Highway Act registered in Police Station Khizarabad, Distt. Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the earlier Order passed by this Court in CRM-M-17220-2018 which is reproduced herein below:-

“Petitioner was part of a mob which gathered on highway on 2.12.2017 to protest pursuant to an incident in which a person died after being run over by a tractor trolley. In order to control the situation, police arrived at the scene. However, police party is alleged to have been assaulted by the petitioner and co-accused. Certain serious injuries are also stated to have been caused to the police personnel particularly, SHO-Virender Singh attracting offence under Section 307 IPC. Petitioner is incarcerated

since 19.01.2018. Investigation qua him is complete and challan has been presented. As the proceedings are likely to take long time to conclude, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. He is directed to be enlarged on bail subject to such terms and conditions as the trial court may deem fit to impose.”

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Shri Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana and submits that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted bail by this Court as well as by the Trial Court. He further submits that out of total 14 accused 13 are already on bail.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail. He be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
