MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (ORAL)

Present petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code ('Cr.P.C.' - for short) has been filed for quashing of FIR No.83 dated 6.5.2014 under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Line, Ludhiana City, Punjab in view of the fact that matter has already been compromised.

Affidavit of Mr. Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana in compliance of order dated 17.4.2018 filed, which is

taken on record. Registry is directed to supply copy of the said affidavit to the opposite side during the course of the day.

Perusal of paragraph No.3 of the same reads as under:-

3. xxxxxx

“Generally, there is no time limit prescribed under the provisions of law for the submission of untrace or cancellation report before the Illaqa Magistrates, but as per the precedent, these should be submitted in the Courts within a reasonable time.”

Further, the contents of paragraph No.4 of the affidavit reveal that untrace report has now been submitted before learned Illaqa Magistrate and summons have been issued to the complainant for 19.5.2018. It is also submitted in this para that Station House Officer (“SHO”-for short) has been specifically directed to submit such types of reports in the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate at the earliest.

In view of the above, no further directions in the present petition is required to be issued. Consequently, this petition stands disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
