Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.185 dated 20.09.2017 under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City South, Moga.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 15.05.2018: -

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegation in the FIR, the complainant had strained relations with one Rinku Jagravan and on that account, he along with 15-20 unknown persons had caused injuries to his brother Sahil @ Landi. It is further submitted that though the complainant has attributed specific allegation against the co-accused, however no

injury is attributed to the petitioner in FIR and it is only, thereafter, by recording the statement of Sahil, the petitioner is named as one of the assailant who has caused injury with a baseball bat. It is further submitted that similarly situated co-accused namely Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi has already been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 14.11.2017 passed in CRM-M No.42857 of 2017 and the same was confirmed on 30.01.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 15.05.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mukhwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.05.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
