Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that the offence under Section 325 of IPC has also been added by the Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner orally requests that Section 325 of IPC be added in the head note and prayer clause of the petition.

Request allowed. Registry is directed to make addition of Section 325 IPC accordingly.

Petitioner Anand Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.194 dated 07.04.2018, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula, District Panchkula, under Sections 323, 452, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 325 of IPC added later on).

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The FIR has been registered under Sections 323, 452, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 325 of IPC added later on).

The grievous injury has not been specifically attributed to the present petitioner.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 15.05.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 15.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
