In the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking permission to travel to North America and Europe between 20.06.2018 to 16.07.2018 and to North America, China/Hongkong and Europe in the month of July 2018 to September 2018 as he is on bail in FIR No.0031 dated 27.01.2016, under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Butana, District Karnal, Haryana (Annexure P-2) with certain conditions including, he will not leave the country without permission. Thus this petition.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dalbir Singh, HPS. Dy. Superintendent of Police, Assandh, Karnal, on behalf of respondent-State, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

In para No.2 of the reply, it is stated as under:-

“ That the petitioner in the present petition has been released on anticipatory bail by this Hon'ble Court. The State of Haryana has no objection in case the petitioner is permitted to travel abroad i.e. to North America and Europe between 20.06.2018 to 16.07.2018 and to North America, China, Singapore and Europe in the month of July 2018 to September 2018 and also keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has never misused the concession of the anticipatory bail granted by this Court.”

In view of the aforesaid submission of the State-respondent, the petitioner is held entitled for relief sought in the present petition.

Accordingly, petition stands allowed. The petitioner is permitted to go abroad during the period from 20.06.2018 to September, 2018 subject to his furnishing surety bond of Rs.1 lac to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned. He shall report on 01.10.2018 before the Court of CJM concerned to take discharge of surety.
