Prayer in this application is for correction in the name and address of petitioner No.2, which is wrongly mentioned as Amarjit Singh son of Chhinder Singh, resident of VPO Madarpur, Tehsil and District Moga.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed. Name and address of petitioner No.2 is ordered to be corrected as Amarjit Singh son of Balbir Singh @ Dillu, resident of Daulewal, P.S. Fatehgarh Panjgur, District Moga. Amended memo of parties dated 17.07.2017 is also taken on record.

CRM stands disposed of.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.116 dated 18.07.2016 under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Harvinder Pal

Singh, submits that petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation and he is no more required for any further investigation.

Petitioner No.1 was directed to join the investigation on 28.09.2017 and thereafter again, one more opportunity was granted to him to join the investigation vide order dated 25.01.2018, however, counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since petitioner No.1 is arrested in some other case, he could not join the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid orders. It was also clarified on the last date of hearing that no further time will be granted to petitioner No.1 for rejoining the investigation and in case he failed to do so, the interim protection granted to him shall stand vacated.

Faced with the above, counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.1.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 22.08.2017 is made absolute only qua petitioner No.2 subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
