Application is allowed and Annuxres P-5 and P-6 are taken on record.

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The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 83 dated 18.9.2017 registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala under Sections 363, 366-A, 34 IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that it was a case of run away marriage and they had performed marriage and they have placed on record photographs. Counsel further submits that challan has been presented and charge has been framed and the girl has not been cited as a witness and the girl had refused to go with the parents and she is lodged in Nari Niketan.

Admittedly, the victim refused to accompany her parents. She

is lodged in Nari Niketan. Challan has already been presented.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
