Petitioner-Gurjinder Singh @ Kaka has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.01 dated 05.01.2017, registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

Heard.

On 17.05.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner made a statement that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and move an application for grant of bail, but the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the aforesaid statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, it was ordered that if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within seven days from that day and moves an application for grant of bail, the same would be decided as per law on the next day.

Since the order has already been passed by the Court, no further action is required in this petition.
