This is an application for placing on record amended memo of parties. Heard. In view of the reasons stated in the application and affidavit, same is allowed.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case.

Grievance of the petitioner is that he moved complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to take action but no action was taken despite the legal notice to implement the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case titled as ***Lalita Kumari versus Government of Uttar Pradesh and others*** and there is violation of supra case.

2. If the concerned official respondent had violated the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme court in the above named case, petitioner has remedy to approach Supreme Court by seeking necessary relief. This court cannot issue direction if any official respondent violates order of the

Hon'ble Supreme Court even otherwise if the authority is not taking action on his complaint, in that case he has remedy to approach the concerned Magistrate for registration of case under the provision of Section 156 of the Cr.P.C. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach appropriate forum.
