The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121 dated 19.04.2018 under Section 12 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

Allegations made in the FIR are only of gesturing. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the allegations in the FIR are not sustainable and also submitted that the matter has been compromised between the parties vide Annexure P.2.

At this stage appearance has been caused on behalf of mother of the complainant who admits to the factum of compromise arrived at between the parties. Learned counsel for the mother of the complainant submits that she would have no objection in case regular

bail would be allowed to the petitioner herein.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State submits that parties should approach the Investigating Officer with the copy of the compromise so that the cancellation report can be prepared, if so required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised and there is no opposition to the grant of regular bail by the complainant herself, the petition is allowed with the direction to the complainant to approach the Investigating Officer for cancellation of the FIR. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
