AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in the light of registration of FIR No.0060 dated 19.03.2018, at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh, under Sections 407 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, against him.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is owner of the vehicle and it is his father, who is driver of the said vehicle. Counsel contends that the petitioner was not aware about the factum of the misappropriation/theft of bags of onions. He, therefore, contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation and cooperate with the same.

Perusal of the translation of the FIR indicates that the petitioner is only the owner of the vehicle, whereas, the vernacular of the FIR clearly

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indicates that the petitioner is not only the owner of the vehicle but the driver as well. Recovery of 30 bags of onions as well as vehicle involved in the commission of offence, of which, petitioner is admittedly the owner, has to be effected from him and therefore, his custodial interrogation is essential.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
