The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with the prayer for calling status report from the SIT, which is investigating the case *i.e.* FIR No.50 dated 31.03.2017 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station North, Chandigarh, so that effective free and fair investigation is done into the immigration fraud, whereby total 373 people have been defrauded of more than 21 crores rupees. A further prayer has also been made for conducting inquiry into the role of the Chandigarh police by the CBI.

Admittedly, one petition bearing CRM-M No.15590 of 2018 is pending before this Court wherein prayer is also the similar and identical with the only difference that in the present case the prayer is also for calling the status report.

Keeping in view the prayer in both the cases, no further direction is required to be issued in this case. How the second petition is maintainable, has been argued that status report is required to be filed.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed being not maintainable.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy to move an application in that case which is pending.
