The present petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR No. 54, dated 04.06.2016 registered under Sections 324, 323, 425, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (later on added Section 326 IPC vide DDR No. 17 dated 27.07.2016) at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 31.05.2017, report dated 12.06.2017 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hoshiarpur. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 54, dated 04.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 324, 323, 425, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (later on added Section 326 IPC vide DDR No. 17 dated 27.07.2016) at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed.
