Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.144 dated 15.09.2016 under Sections 283, 341, 188, 431, 148, 149 IPC and Section 8-B of National Highway Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed on 15.05.2018: -

“Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the coaccused of the petitioners namely Darbara Singh has already been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 08.06.2017 passed in CRM-M No.21517 of 2017, which was confirmed on 29.08.2017 and similarly, other co-accused i.e. Prem Singh and others have also been granted the concession of interim

anticipatory bail vide order dated 08.03.2018 passed in CRM-M No.8538 of 2018 and another co-accused of the petitioners namely Kulwant Singh has also been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 21.03.2018 passed in CRM-M No.11784 of 2018. It is further submitted that there is no evidence against the petitioners that the highway was blocked.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the order dated 15.05.2018, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sawinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 15.05.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
