AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This appeal has been filed for enhancement of compensation on account of injuries received by him in an accident during the course of his employment. Since only a limited issue is involved in the present appeal further detailed reference to the facts would not be necessary.

The appellant was driving a vehicle on a fateful day when he met with an accident. The Commissioner assessed his disability at 25% and awarded sum of Rs.37,912/- alongwith penalty and interest.

It transpires that pursuant to this accident the appellant had been relieved from his service but he filed a writ petition challenging his retirement on medical ground which was ultimately allowed and he was granted all back-wages. In the circumstances, there is no scope for any interference in the award.

Appeal is dismissed. No costs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
