The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.46 dated 2.4.2018, under Sections 406, 420, 34 IPC, Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner had cheated the complainant of an amount of ₹7,50,000/- on the pretext of sending his son to Italy.

Notice of motion was issued to the respondents.

On the last date of hearing Mr. Vishal Munjal, Advocate had put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant and had duly acknowledged the compromise as had been contended by the petitioner.

It has been informed by learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, that the petitioner has since joined the investigation.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, in my opinion it is not a case of custodial interrogation. The petition is as such accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 16.5.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners would appear before the learned trial Court regularly and abide by any other condition as may be imposed by the learned trial Court.

The petition is accepted in the above mentioned terms.
