Petitioners seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 430 dated 16.12.2017, under Sections 313, 420, 494, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S.Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The complainant wife seeks to pressurize the petitioner to act according to her wishes. No recovery has to be effected from the petitioner, therefore this petition be allowed.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per allegations in the FIR, petitioner solemnized marriage with the complainant by keeping her in dark regarding his first marriage. There are allegations of termination of her pregnancy twice in a forcible manner. Reference is also made to the dispute raised by the first wife as well as the instances where the matter was placed before the Women Cell, S.A.S.Nagar, Mohali. There are specific allegations against the petitioner. I do not find any ground whatsoever to afford the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the facts and circumstances of this case. This petition is accordingly dismissed.

It is clarified that the observations in this order are solely confined for the purpose of decision of this petition and shall have no bearing on the investigation/trial of the case.
