The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.604 dated 18.07.2017, registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.
