Petitioner-Kamal Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.29 dated 31.03.2018, registered at Police Station GRP Hisar, District GRP Ambala Cantt., under Sections 328 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of complainant-Parmod Kumar Kushwaha. As per the FIR, when the complainant was going in train,

then a boy came there and sat in front of him. They had conversations with each other. Then, the said boy offered Pepsi from a bottle to the complainant. After consuming the same, the complainant started feeling sleepy. The said boy took away bag of complainant containing mobile phone, clothes, ₹2600/- etc.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.04.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
