The petitioner is seeking direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 0032, dated 07.02.2018, under Sections 279, 337, 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Tripri, District Patiala. Further, a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the accused in the afore-noted FIR has also been sought.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner and his father, who were travelling on a Scooter, were hit by an offending vehicle, which was an SUV registered in the name of Swaraj Automotive Limited. Learned counsel further contends that although FIR has been registered but the matter is not being fairly investigated and respondent No. 3 is pressurising the petitioner to compromise the matter.

Heard.

The petitioner has not approached any of the superior

officials with regard to his demand for free and fair investigation. No application has been made to any police officer in this regard.

Therefore, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make an application to respondent No. 2 and in the event of such an application being filed, respondent No. 2 is directed to consider the same and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law expeditiously.
