Earlier the present petitioner had filed Criminal Misc. M No.2740 of 2018 (Gurjeet Singh Brar Vs. State of Punjab) on the same cause of action and after arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner sought permission to withdraw the same and vide order 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-3), the aforesaid petition was dismissed as withdrawn.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that the change in circumstances is an affidavit dated 05.02.2018 (Annexure P-6), which has been filed by the complainant now, wherein it has been stated by the complainant that it was under a misconception that such an allegation has been made in the FIR against the petitioner.

This Court is not satisfied and would not be in a position to agree with the affidavit of the complainant, which has now been filed.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations against the petitioner, I do not find any merit in the present petition. The same stands dismissed.
