As per the allegations in the FIR, the injury attributed to petitioner No.1 Gabbar Singh is simple in nature. Co-accused of the petitioners namely Dharamjodh Singh, Charat Singh, Joravar Singh and Kashmir Singh have been released on interim bail and the same has been made absolute.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 Gabbar Singh has joined investigation and learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh also affirms this fact.

Accordingly, interim order dated 17.05.2018 passed by this Court in favour of petitioner No.1 Gabbar Singh is made absolute.

As far as petitioner No.2 Manpreet Singh alias Manna is concerned, injury under Section 326 IPC has been attributed to him. Initially

Section 326 IPC was not there and the same has been added subsequently qua petitioner No.2 Manpreet Singh alias Manna. Therefore, present petition qua petitioner No.2 Manpreet Singh alias Manna stands dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
