Prayer in this petition is for grant of benefit to the petitioner as has been granted to his co-accused Madan, in FIR No.99 dated 24.03.2003, under Sections 302, 381, 120-B, 381, 212 and 216 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, in which, petitioner and co-accused Madan stand convicted and sentenced to undergone life imprisonment vide judgment and order dated 27/28.02.2017 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar.

Petitioner, at present, is housed in Jalpaiguri Central Correctional Home (West Bengal) as he belongs to that area and was transferred there in the year 2014 on a request submitted by him. The co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Madan, has been granted the benefit of release on good conduct vide order dated 25.12.2017 passed by the Department of Prison, Haryana (Annexure P-2). On this basis, counsel contends that the petitioner is also entitled to the same benefit as has been granted to his co-accused Madan.

Making request to that effect, a representation dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted to the Director General (Prison), Haryana-respondent No.2, which has been received in the office of the said authority vide Diary No.92 dated 13.03.2018. He states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the said authority to consider and decide the representation dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) submitted by him, within some specified time.

In the light of the statement of the counsel for the petitioner, without going into merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police (Prison), Haryana-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representation dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
