Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 113 dated 7.12.2017, registered under Sections 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Section 354-D, 406, 506 IPC, Women Police Station, Palwal, Haryana.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 18.1.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Compromise has been effected. A separate petition for quashing of the FIR is fixed for today. The parties have been directed to
