This is the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 16.03.2018 under Sections 307 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, Distt. Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that its a case of road accident in which the name of the petitioner has been unnecessarily dragged because of some collateral grievance regarding property distribution during partition. Counsel further submits that in any case the injuries suffered by the injured witness are only simple in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 23.03.2018.

Learned State counsel being instructed by Sarulanjit Singh; does not dispute the fact regarding the injuries being simple, however, it is submitted that since serious offence of attempt to murder is involved, therefore, the petitioner does not deserve any concession.

The veracity of the version of the prosecution is yet to be

tested by leading the evidence. The fact remains that the injuries suffered by the injured are simple in nature. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on merits, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during the pendency of Trial; subject to furnishing bail bond/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
