The petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.631 dated 23.04.2017 registered under Sections 489A, 489B, 489C & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Jagadhri District Yamuna Nagar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Undoubtedly the offence is serious and against the interest of nation in circulating fake currency notes to the extent of ₹67000.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes statement, on instructions from the petitioner that he is ready to deposit an amount of ₹67000 (rupees sixty seven thousand only) with the treasury at District Yamuna Nagar, within a period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner is allowed to do so.

Looking to the custody period and the fact that the petitioner is ready to deposit the amount as aforesaid, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-21058 OF 2018 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner to deposit an amount of ₹67000 with the Treasury, Yamuna Nagar, which shall be forfeited to the State.
- (iii) The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate, against receipt of deposit of amount as aforesaid.
- (iv) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
