State of Punjab and others', who also was admittedly in contact with said Avijit Arora and

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transcript of their telephone conversation has also been placed on record in the aforesaid case and whose apprehension appears to be very necessary.

For the aforesaid reasons, interim bail granted to the petitioner stands recalled and the prayer for anticipatory bail stands rejected.
