The petitioners are a co-accused, seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 21 dated 16.03.2018, under Sections 323/324/307/148/149 of the IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bhindi Saida, District Amritsar (Rural).

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Charan Singh, states that co-accused Buta Singh has been arrested. Necessary recovery has been made. It is also stated that co-accused are already on bail.

3. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners are not required for the custodial interrogation as stated by the learned State counsel though the petitioners may be required for the follow up investigation/interrogation. Hence, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and to join the investigation.

4. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bond to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they will bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed.
