In the present petition, petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No. 27, dated 06.03.2013, under Sections 323/325/506/34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kharar, SAS Nagar (Annexure P/1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 26.04.2018 (Annexure P/2).

2. This Court by the order dated 17.05.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kharar has sent his report dated 29.05.2018 wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

3. In view of the law laid down in *Narinder Singh vs. State of*

Punjab reported in **(2014) 6 SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, present petition is allowed and FIR No. 27, dated 06.03.2013, under Sections 323/325/506/34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kharar, SAS Nagar (Annexure P/1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed.

4. Petitioners are liable to pay litigation cost of Rs. 6000/- (Rs.2000/- each) to the Home Department, State of Punjab within a period of two months from today.
